# Tax Preparation Checklist

### Personal

- o Social Security numbers and dates of birth for you, your spouse, your dependents
- o Copy of tax payer (and spouse) driver's license
- o Copy of any/all dependents' social security card
- o Copies of last year's tax return for you and your spouse
- Bank account number and routing number, if depositing your refund directly into your account.

#### Income

- o W-2 forms for you and your spouse
- o 1099 Forms
  - o 1099-C for cancellation of debt
  - o 1099-MISC for you and your spouse
  - o 1099-G for unemployment income, or state or local tax refunds
  - SSA-1099 for Social Security benefits received
  - o 1099-R, Form 8606 for payments/distributions from IRAs or retirement plans
  - o 1099-INT, -DIV, -B, or K-1s for investment or interest income
  - o 1099-S forms for income from sale of a property
- Miscellaneous income: jury duty, gambling winnings, Medical Savings Account, scholarships, etc.
- Alimony received
- o Business or farming income profit/loss statement, capital equipment information
- o Rental property income and expenses: profit/loss statement, suspended loss information
- Prior year installment sale information Forms 6252, principal and interest collected during the year, SSN and address for payer

## Income Adjustments

- o Form 1098-E for student loan interest paid (or loan statements for student loans)
- o Form 1098-T for tuition paid (or receipts/canceled checks for tuition paid for post-high school)
- o Records of IRA contributions made during the year
- o Receipts for any qualifying energy-efficient home improvements (solar, windows, etc.)
- o Records of Medical Savings Account (MSA) contributions

- o Self-employed health insurance payment records
- o Records of moving expenses
- Alimony paid
- o Keogh, SEP, SIMPLE, and other self-employed pension plans

#### **Deductions**

- Child care
  - o Provider's name, address
  - o Tax ID and amount paid
- o Form 1098-T for education expenses
- o Adoption costs
  - o SSN of child
  - o Records of legal, medical and transportation costs
- o Forms 1098 for Mortgage interest, private mortgage insurance (PMI), and points you paid
- o Investment interest expenses
- Charitable donations
  - o Cash amounts, official charity receipts, canceled checks; value of donated, property; miles driven and out-of-pocket expenses
- o Medical and dental expense records
- o Casualty and theft losses
  - o Amount of damage and insurance reimbursements
- o Records and amounts of other miscellaneous tax deductions
  - Union dues
  - o Unreimbursed employee expenses
    - o uniforms, supplies, seminars, continuing education, publications, travel, etc.
- o Records of home business expenses
  - o Home size/office size, home expenses
- Rental property income/expenses
  - o Profit/loss statement, rental property suspended loss information

# Taxes paid

- o State and local income taxes paid
- o Real estate taxes paid
- o Personal property taxes
- Vehicle license fees based on value of vehicle
- o Estimated tax payments made during the year
- o Prior-year refund applied to current year and/or any amount paid with an extension to file
